PERSONAL SAFETY BULLETIN Helmet and Apparel Wear

Notice to all Drivers and Guardians.

We felt it necessary to release this bulletin to remind Drivers and Guardians that it's you who is responsible for your safety, that your safety equipment must be in good order and that your helmet fits and worn correctly.

Please inspect your equipment before use and make sure you.

- Helmet
 - Is the correct size.
 - In date
 - Type approved for use.
 - In good condition without damage.
 - Worn correctly and the **strap is done up**.
 - Visor clear, sound and retained when down.
- Head and Neck Restraint is of a type approved in section 17.5, it's in good condition and **worn correctly**
- Driving Suits is of standard, no holes or rips and the zipper fully functional
- Boots meet the standard, fit correctly in good condition with no Holes
- Gloves meet the standard, again fit right, in good condition with no holes
- There is no skin showing and that everything fits.

When purchasing your equipment please consult the supplier to ensure your purchase is of the correct type, it's comfortable and that it fits you the driver. Borrowed or poorly fitted safety apparelled is not safe.

Ensure all of the above meets the standard or type set out in the Speedway Australia Racing Rules – Section 17

Take care of your equipment especially your helmet and neck restrain. Follow the manufactures care and use instructions, keep clean, service and wash the equipment after use.
